

# SAP How to find transaction by program name?



So, find the three common ways how to find transaction by program name below:

## 1. Find transaction via **TSTC** table:

Go to **SE16N** -> Enter table name **TSTC** -> Enter program name and execute

Go to **SE80** -> Select "**Repository Browser**" -> Select "**Program**" or "**Development Object**" -> Enter program name, ENTER (or glasses button) -> Expand "**Transactions**" folder
